- Names guardians for your children upon your passing

- Are fairly easy to establish, easier to modify, and involve very little maintenance
- Is public record

-Allow you to name beneficiaries for property

-Allow revisions after it has been completed and made legal

-Allow you to leave property to minors

Trusts

- Help avoid probate
- Offer protection from court challenges
- Avoid conservatorship
- Can be costly to have drawn up, need ongoing maintenance, and can be time-consuming to establish
- Is confidential, and ideal for those with a large net worth
